In 2023, we were thankful to have you and other supporters who have helped us with the accomplishments and impacts made by Pikes Peak Hospice and Palliative Care.

Your belief in our mission shows your commitment to our community; your support helps us to make compassionate care the hallmark of our work.

We provide care in El Paso, Teller and Elbert counties for those with an advanced medical condition and those who are grieving.

We are comprised of just over 100 team members, more than 125 volunteers and Board Directors and Trustees who are committed to building on our existing strengths and growing our services.

A few highlights of our 2023 care delivery include:

We served 1,782 hospice and palliative care patients.

We provided over 1,000 bereavement services to individuals, families and children.

Our annual "Illuminations" event raised over \$66,000 to support special patient programs.

We provided \$215,000 of Charity Care to people who were terminally ill and had no means to pay for healthcare.

We provided eight Sentimental Journeys to ensure bucket list experiences were completed.

We provided \$44,278 in Patient Special Needs to pay for groceries, rent, gas, water, food and more.





CHARITY CARE & SPECIAL PROGRAMS






